## An Initiative within the Mass Save® Home Energy Services Program

If you live in **Belchertown, East Longmeadow, Hampden, Longmeadow, Monson, Palmer, Springfield, or Wilbraham** you are eligible for Home MPG.

## Home MPG offers:

- An energy performance score for homes, similar to a miles-per-gallon rating for a car
- Higher incentives for air sealing and insulation, up to \$3,750!
- Thermal images that highlight energy savings opportunities
- Extra rebates to upgrade to high-efficiency heating and hot water equipment
- 0% interest loans from local banks

## Heat losses from a partially insulated home.

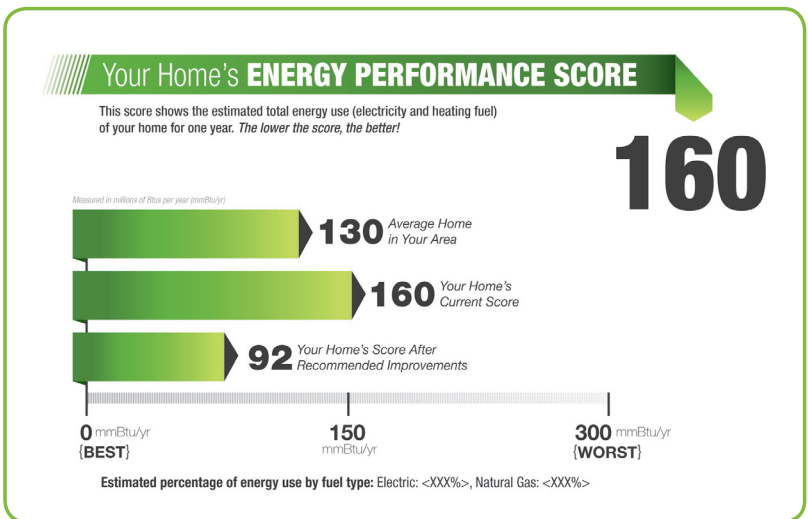


Homeowners in the eight communities may receive thermal images of their homes. A visual report shows precisely which windows, doors, walls, roof segments and other building envelope components are most in need of attention.

## Energy Performance Score (EPS)

### A Miles-Per-Gallon Rating for Your Home

The Energy Performance Score (EPS) is a tool to assess a home's energy consumption, cost and carbon footprint. **THE LOWER THE SCORE, THE BETTER!** The EPS also allows for comparisons of one home's energy use to another, without the influence of varying occupant behavior.



The EPS calculation is based on a home's size, design, insulation levels, air leakage, heating and cooling systems, major appliances, lighting, and hot water heating. Occupancy, behavior, indoor temperature, and regional weather are standardized to calculate normal energy use.
