## WILBRAHAM ANNOUNCES FIRST COVID-19 CASE

The Town of Wilbraham Board of Health announces that a Wilbraham resident has tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus). The Health Department, along with the Department of Public Health, has provided guidance for the quarantine of the individual, household and family members. The Board of Health advises all residents to comply with Governor Baker's Stay-At-Home Advisory and closure of non-essential businesses effective today March 24, 2020 at noon until April 7, 2020 at noon.

The Board of Health advises all residents to frequently wash their hands with soap and water for a full twenty seconds, to practice social distancing when out in the public by staying at least six feet apart, avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth, clean things that are frequently touched with household spray or wipes, cover your mouth with you cough or sneeze, and stay home if you are sick, avoiding contact with others.
