Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2020 elections

Deadline to register to vote and change party enrollment for the General Election:

Saturday, October 24, 2020 – 2:00 – 4:00 PM & 7:00 – 8:00 PM

Deadline to apply for a vote by mail ballot before the General Election:

Wednesday, October 28, 2020 – 5:00 PM

There are two ways to apply for a vote by mail ballot:

Fill out the postcard you received from the Secretary of State's Office and return. You can drop in the mail (postage paid) or put in the Drop Box at town hall)
